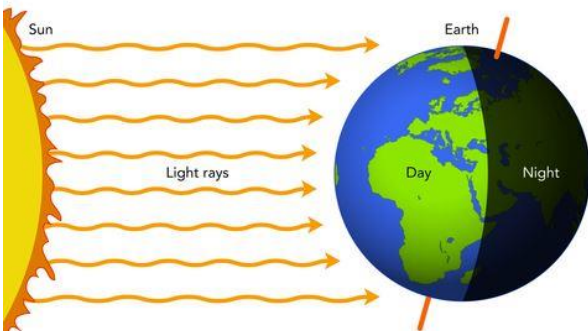


## Months and the Seasons



## Day and Night

The earth **rotates** (spins) around on its **axis** (imaginary line). We get **day** and **night** because the earth **rotates**.



**Daytime** - for the countries facing the sun, where it is light.

**Night time** - for the countries facing away from the sun, where it is dark.

## Trees and the Seasons

**Deciduous trees** lose their leaves in the Autumn.

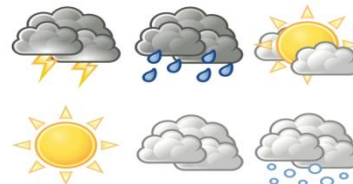
How do the leaves change through the year?



**Evergreen trees** do not lose their leaves in the Autumn. They stay green all year around.

## Animals and the Seasons

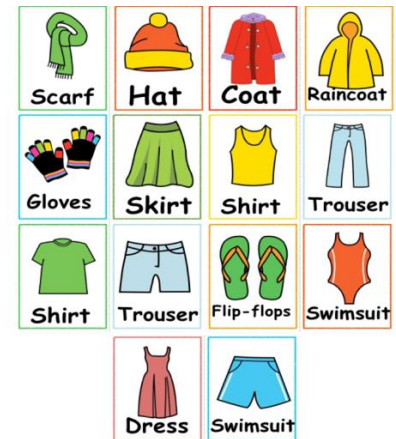
**Winter** - Animals **hibernate** because it is cold and there is not much food to eat.
