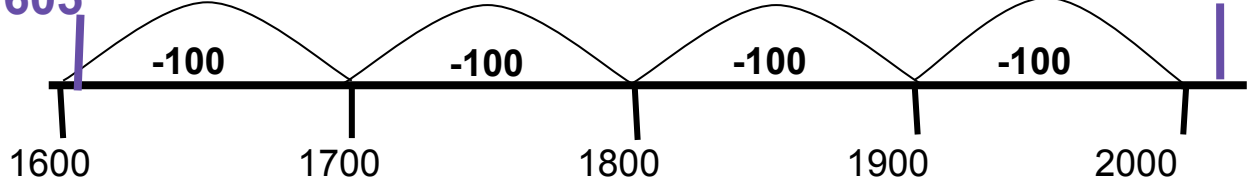

Key dates and vocabulary:

King James I: King of England and Scotland. **Protestant.**

Guy Fawkes: Explosives expert. Plotted to blow up the Houses of Parliament in 1605. **Catholic.**

Protestants and **Catholics** are Christians who disagree about how to worship.

Houses of Parliament: Buildings in London, where the government meets to pass laws..

Plotters: A group of 12 Catholic men.

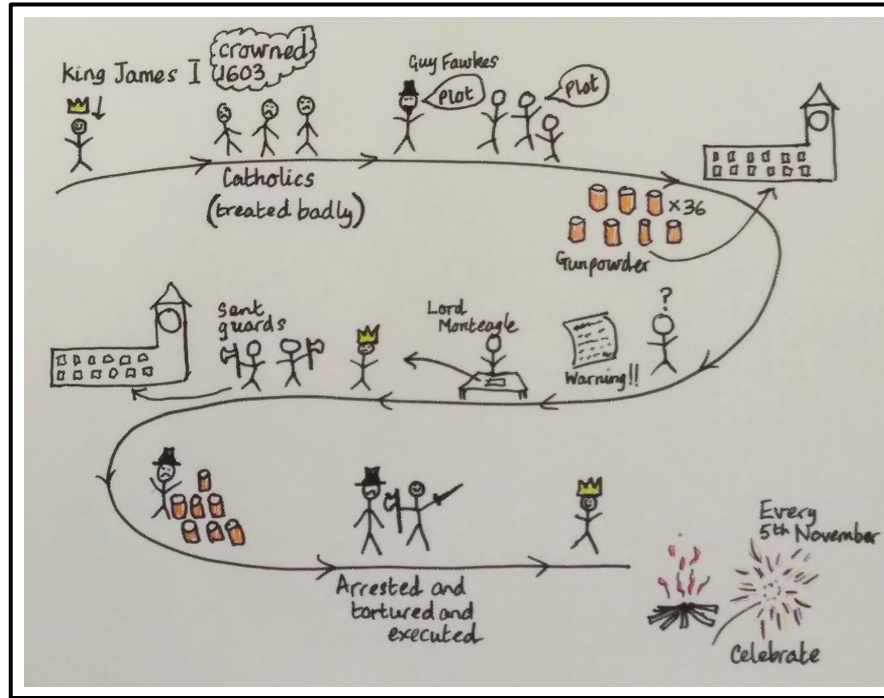
Lord Monteaagle: Received a letter warning him not to attend the opening of Parliament.

Treason: The act of plotting or carrying out a crime against the King or ruler.

5th November 1605: The King's guards discover Guy Fawkes and arrest him.

Bonfire Night: The 5th November. Celebrating the fact that the plot was discovered.

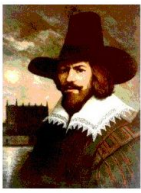
